Central Area Plan Committee The Central Area Plan Committee is established to provide advice and recommendations to the BURA Board and City Council on matters pertaining to parking, the Central Area Plan, and urban renewal/Downtown projects. Applications will be accepted from land/business owners or residents of the Downtown Core area and will be appointed for a one-year term. Traffic Safety Advisory Committee Committee members are appointed to recommend traffic safety improvements and traffic safety programs. Applicants must be residents of the City of Bend.
