

7th Annual Make-a-Wish Radiothon exceeds goal

(BEND, Ore.) — The seventh annual Make-A-Wish Radiothon exceeded its goal and raised \$40,465 and 392,454 frequent flier miles that will help grant six wishes to children living with life-threatening medical conditions in Central Oregon.
