

Sex offender charged in boy's killing

LOUISVILLE, Ky. - A Kentucky man pleaded not guilty Thursday to the murder of a 4-year-old boy whose body was found in the trash near his home. Cecil New of Louisville was indicted Wednesday on charges that included killing Cesar Ivan Aguilar-Cano and kidnapping, The Louisville Courier-Journal reported. New, who was convicted of sex offenses in 1992, was also charged with being a persistent felony offender. New is being held in lieu of \$1 million cash bail. The boy's body was discovered July 7 in the back of a garbage truck. The child, who had last been seen more than a week earlier outside his home near Churchill Downs, was identified two days later. A preliminary hearing was scheduled for January.
