

Westlund Welcomed by Senate Democratic Caucus

The Senate Democratic Caucus today welcomed Senator Ben Westlund (D-Bend) as its newest member. The welcome came after Westlund announced that he is changing his registration from Independent to Democrat.

“We are very happy to have Senator Westlund join our caucus and the Democratic Party,” said Senate Majority Leader Kate Brown (D-Portland). “Senator Westlund will bring a wealth of experience and a valuable Central Oregon perspective to our discussions on critical issues like health care, education and renewable energy.”

In announcing his decision to join the Democratic Party, Westlund said:
