Cook Harvey, Chief Investigator for the Department of Justice Charitable Activities Section, will present information about legal and illegal forms of gaming at the meeting. Two lottery investigators from the Oregon State Police will assist with the presentation and will review Lottery Commission rules regarding legal and illegal forms of gaming. At the social gaming meeting, a detective from the Bend Police Department will speak about recent, local gaming investigations.
