The flushed, red faces of some drinkers could be a sign they're at greater risk of throat cancer, say researchers at the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism.

The flushing response, which can be accompanied by nausea and a rapid heartbeat, is primarily caused by an inherited deficiency in an enzyme called ALDH2, which results in difficulties in metabolizing alcohol and an accumulation of toxic acetaldehyde in the body.

That toxic buildup may lead to squamous cell esophageal cancer, said Dr. Philip J. Brooks, which can be surgically treated. The survival rate, however, is very low.

Moderate drinking increases the risk, but heavy consumption is especially problematic. An ALDH2-deficient person who has two beers a day is six to 10 times more likely to develop esophageal cancer than a person not deficient in the enzyme.

ALDH2 deficiency is a trait shared by more than one-third of people of East Asian ancestry (Japanese, Chinese, Korean).

A new British study of 900,000 adults found that even moderate obesity, defined as a body mass index of 30 to 35, takes two to four years off life expectancy. Severe obesity cuts eight to 10 years.

NUMBER CRUNCHER

A large, toasted plain bagel (123 grams) contains 354 calories, 19 from fat. It has 2.1 grams of total fat or 3 percent of the recommended total fat intake for a 2,000-calorie daily diet.

It also contains no cholesterol; 590 milligrams of sodium (25 percent); 70 grams of total carbohydrates (23 percent); 3.2 g of dietary fiber (13 percent); 7.2 g of sugar and 13 g of protein.
