

Salem Police ask for help in locating fraud suspects

Ashley Coleman, 20, and Brian Stift, 25, are wanted for questioning in several cases involving counterfeit checks that were passed at local businesses. The pair allegedly manufactured checks using victims' bank accounts, passing them primarily at Fred Meyer and Wal-mart stores in various police jurisdictions.

Police think Coleman and Stift are currently in the Portland area. Both have outstanding arrest warrants on unrelated charges.
