

Bend snowboarder, 14, paralyzed in fall

A 14-year-old snowboarder from Bend was paralyzed when he fell while training for a competition at Northstar Resort near Lake Tahoe Sunday.

A donation account has been established at U.S. Bank on behalf of Tyler Eklund “ MBSEF photo Tyler Eklund was practicing for the USASA National Championships when he broke a vertebra in his neck. He was airlifted to Reno and underwent emergency surgery, but according to Mt. Bachelor Sports Education Foundation (MBSEF) officials, his injury “was such that in all probability he will remain paralyzed”.
