The top three finishers take home â€œSummer Prize Packsâ€• supplied by local sponsors. The event starts at 10 A.M. on the slopes in front of the West Village Lodge. Registration is open now through the day of the event. The cost is \$25 and participants must be at least nine-years-old.

Thanks to recent snowfall, the mountain has 86 inches of snow at the base and 118 inches at mid-mountain.
