
Near \$.5 million grant to aid ex-Seaswirl workers by Bend_Weekly_News_Sources Grants also awarded to assist former employees of TTM Technologies in Dallas, and Weyerhauser's Bauman Plywood in Lebanon The U.S. Department of Labor has announced a \$490,930 grant to provide assistance to approximately 100 workers affected by the closure of Seaswirl Boats in Culver, Ore. "This \$490,930 grant will help workers access employment services and training opportunities so they can transition to new jobs in growing industries,― said Secretary of Labor Elaine L. Chao.

The grant, awarded to the Oregon Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development, will provide affected workers with an array of employment services that may include assessment, individual counseling, career and occupational skills training, and adult education.
