

Mt. Bachelor opens for summer activities

The Pine Marten Express lift will begin turning at 11 a.m. on Saturday morning. This marks the beginning of summer operations at Mt. Bachelor. All activities will move back to the West Village Base Area this year. A return to the west side of the mountain means a return of evening dining at Scapolo™s, located in the mid-mountain Pine Marten Lodge, including the weekend Sunset Dinners and Labor Day weekend Twilight Dinners.

One ride day lift tickets are \$15 for adults (13-64 years), \$12 for seniors (65 years and up), \$9 for youth (12 years and under) and kids five years and under are free. Evening tickets are \$12 for adults, \$10 for seniors, \$7 for youth and five years and under are free. Season Passes are valid during the summer for unlimited rides. Please note, Mid-Week Season Passes will only be valid mid-week in the summer.

For the first time ever, Mt. Bachelor will also offer a Summer Season Pass. Perfect for the avid Disc Golfer, the Summer Season Pass gives you unlimited lift rides in the summer and costs \$79. Please note, all prices and dates are subject to change.
