In an effort to raise \$1,450,000 for 24 non-profit agencies and 33 programs in Deschutes County, pacesetters Microsemi and UPS along with other early campaigns have raised over \$50,000 to jump start the 2006-07 annual United Way campaign.

“It’s a great start to the campaign, but there’s a long way to go,” said Campaign Chair Cyndy Cook, Executive Director of Housing Works. “If this is any indication of how the campaign will progress, we will certainly meet our goal of \$1,450,000.”
