

Two Chinese arrested in Iran as spies

TEHRAN -- Two Chinese nationals were arrested in Iran Wednesday, allegedly for taking pictures of nuclear installations. The Kuwait News Agency quoted an Iranian justice department official as saying the two who had entered Iranian territory through the Kish Island off the southern coast were now being investigated by authorities in the city of Arak in central Iran. The official told Iranian television they were caught taking pictures of military and nuclear centers in Arak.
