

## Report: U.S. to gain 105 million by 2060

WASHINGTON - A conservative research group said a new report shows if current immigration trends continue, 105 million people will be added to the U.S. population by 2060. A release by the Washington-based Center for Immigration Studies said the findings were "carefully modeled on earlier projections by the Census Bureau." The report, "100 Million More: Projecting the Impact of Immigration on the U.S. Population, 2007 to 2060," will be available online at [cis.org](http://cis.org), the center said. The report said that 1.6 million legal and illegal immigrants settle in the United States each year, while 350,000 leave each year "resulting in a net immigration increase of 1.25 million. By 2060, the U.S. population will be 468 million if current trends continue, the report said.
